## How this program-based portfolio example is set up and how to read it

With permission of the student-author, we have tailored this portfolio for use as an example of a program-based portfolio. All names and identifying places have been redacted. Redactions done with markings follow the method of redaction CLA recommends learners use in their own PLAR portfolio. For this example portfolio, identifying information that would not normally be redacted from a learner's portfolio has been replaced with "xx" notations to respect the writer's confidentiality.

This portfolio addresses the outcomes for the Bachelor of Professional Arts – Communication Studies program. This model is applicable to all programs that require program-based portfolio submissions.

What we provide is an example of a good program-based portfolio that was thoroughly and meticulously prepared. Only a fraction of the original portfolio supporting documents are displayed. This portfolio example may not adhere to current submission standards.
